



HEADWRAPPERS' STEP BY STEP SCARF TYING GUIDE **BASIC HEADWRAP WITH A TWIST**

You Will Need: A square scarf (1m square) and one long thin scarf (approx 100 x 20 cm). The same as our complimentary scarves.



Step 1 Take the square scarf and fold it into a triangle. Place it over the head with the point of the triangle going down your back. Tie once so that it feels secure.

Step 2 Tuck the loose triangle tail up inside the scarf, by the knot, at the nape of the neck, leaving a scarf tail on either side.



Step 3 Twist the two tails and bring to the front, securing with a knot or tucking in to twisted section. By tucking the excess scarf under at the back, it gives the illusion of hair being under the scarf. The scarf can be worn like this, but continue for a more flattering look.



Step 4 Take the long thin scarf. Thread it equally through the twisted tied section at the forehead. Weave it in and out working towards the back of the head. The two ends can be tucked up under the scarf at the nape of the neck.



The finished result.
